85TH ANNIVERSARY OF A.A. IN WASHINGTON CELEBRATION – FAQ

What is being celebrated?

In April 2026, Alcoholics Anonymous in Washington State will celebrate 85 years of continuous recovery. The first recognized A.A. meeting in Washington took place on April 19, 1941.

How did A.A. begin in Washington?

After the publication of the Big Book, alcoholics in Washington contacted the New York A.A. office for help. On April 19, 1941, four alcoholics met in Room 522 of the New Washington Hotel, recognized as the first A.A. meeting in Washington State.

When is the 85th Anniversary Celebration?

April 18, 2026 at Emerald Downs. Planning includes archives displays, speakers, lunch and dinner.

Who is organizing the celebration?

The Washington 85th Anniversary Celebration Planning Committee, with participation from Western Washington Area 72, Washington East Area 92, Intergroups and Central Service Offices and individual members statewide.

How large is this event expected to be?

This is expected to be one of the largest A.A. gatherings in Washington State since the 1990 International Convention.

How is the celebration being funded?

Entirely funded by members' donations, event registrations (which include meals) and several fundraising options including orange and green 85th Anniversary contribution cans, donations for a commemorative archive book, an 85th Anniversary poker chip, and other activities before and during the event.

What is the commemorative Archival Book?

A commemorative Book will record member contributions and become part of the A.A. Archives.
