

Archivist Motion 2026

PROPOSAL

To *fully fund* our WSEA 92 appointed Archivist to attend the Regional Archives Workshop, and the National AA Archives Workshop.

PURPOSE

We ask the Area to consider funding for archivist required training. The body assigned the Area Archivist responsible for the physical and intellectual integrity, and accountability of the Area's Archival Collection.

BACKGROUND

Respectfully, Area 92, there has been no financial revision for funding travel expenses for the Archivist to attend the National Archives Workshop in nineteen years, and no revision for funding travel to Regional Archives Workshop in ten years. We ask our trusted servants to give freely of their time and experience, but to personally bear the financial burden of travel, the costs of mileage, lodging, and registration required to fulfill the duties of their positions, is an unreasonable expectation.

This motion reflects our commitment to the responsible stewardship, equitable service, and the long-term preservation of our collective history. It offers the most effective way to protect our archives while honoring the spirit of service upon which Alcoholics Anonymous was built.

WHAT HAPPENS IF THE MOTION PASSES

Changes to the WSEA 92 HANDBOOK will be made:

Expenses reimbursed by WSEA 92:

CURRENT LANGUAGE:

1. National Archives Workshop (One per four-year rotation)
 - a. Reimbursement not to exceed \$750.
2. Regional Archives Workshop when hosted by WSEA 92
 - a. Reimbursement not to exceed \$150

UPDATED LANGUAGE:

1. National A.A. Archives Workshop (One per four-year rotation).
 - a. Fully funded for all reasonable travel, lodging, and registration costs to the National Archivist Workshop one time per four year rotation.
2. Regional Archives Workshop (annually)
 - a. Fully funded for all reasonable travel, lodging, and registration costs.
3. Regional Archives Workshop when hosted by WSEA 92 every three years.
 - a. Fully Funded (see section 3.0, Item I, WSEA 92 Handbook)

WHAT IF THE MOTION FAILS

Everything remains as it is.
